On **Sunday, December 3**, we will visit the Tech Museum, where we will experience *Body Worlds Decoded*, view the IMAX film, *Dream Big*, and visit selected museum galleries. In *Body Worlds Decoded*, we will use augmented reality and other emerging technologies to explore human anatomy. During the IMAX film *Dream Big*, we will learn about how innovation, persistence, creativity, and compassion transform engineering.

Since we are getting a special school group rate, this event is limited to 12 student participants, so only GEMS members, friends over 12 years old, and chaperones, please. **AAUW will purchase the Tech Museum tickets and lunch (sandwich and fountain drink) for GEMS members ONLY.**

After lunch, we will attend our 2 PM IMAX showing, then visit selected permanent exhibits and galleries.
