

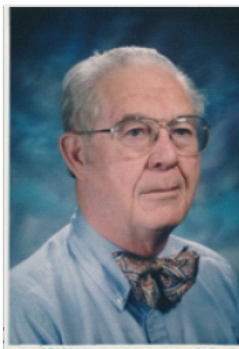
REMEMBERING BILL KEIG
