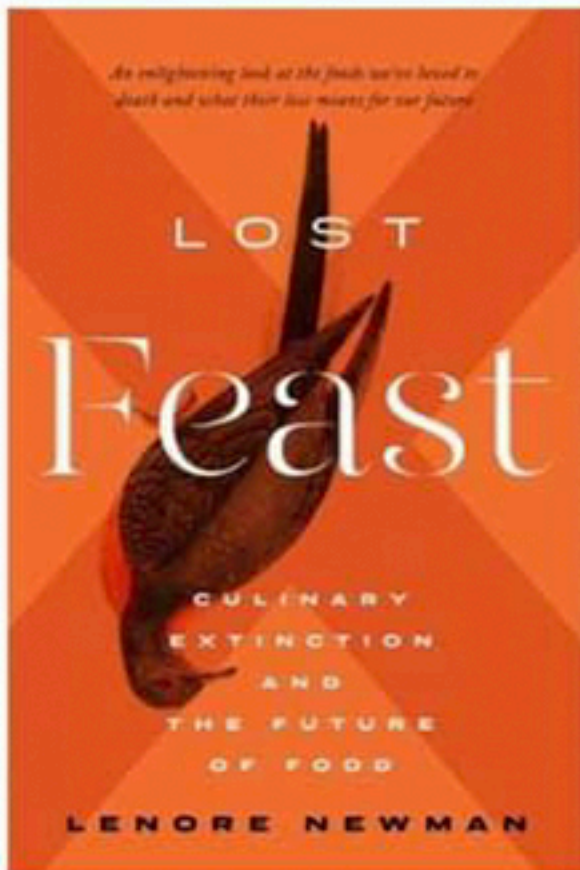


CULINARY EXTINCTION & THE FUTURE OF FOOD
